



### Remote Learning Protocol

What to do if your student is....	Sick	Covid-19 Symptoms
<b>Communication</b>	Parents will call their home school attendance line to report students' absences.	Parents will call the school with Covid-19 related symptoms and/or results as soon as possible.
<b>Process</b>	<p>If your student is absent due to non-Covid-19 related symptoms he/she will stay home and will be marked absent. After the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, the school nurse will follow-up with a phone call to determine the following steps.</p> <p>Sick can be defined as not feeling well enough to attend school.</p>	<p>If after speaking with the nurse, it is determined your student has COVID-19 like symptoms and must quarantine. Your child will participate in remote instruction.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Or</p> <p>If after speaking with the nurse it is determined that your student is a direct contact to some who has tested positive and must quarantine. Your child will participate in remote instruction.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Or</p> <p>Has tested positive for Covid-19 and must quarantine. Your child will participate in remote instruction.</p>
<b>Expectations</b>	Your student will be marked absent and will not participate in remote learning.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ If quarantine occurs 1 hour prior to dismissal, remote learning will begin the next day.</li> <li>➤ If quarantine occurs after, remote learning will begin the following day.</li> </ul> <p>During remote instruction students will receive direct instruction via a TEAMS meeting. Direct instruction may look different in every building. Please refer to your building schedule. Students will have access to their online resources through Class Link.</p>
