Children in grades 3-8 are eligible to enter the Acorn Public Library's *Bookmark Contest* for National Library Week, April 8-14, 2012.

Use the space provided at the bottom of this form to design an original bookmark. Your slogan should include the theme for National Library week: "YOU BELONG @ YOUR LIBRARY." Copyrighted characters such as Disney characters, Spiderman, or Mickey Mouse are not allowed.

All entry forms must be signed by a parent in order to be eligible for the contest.

Use only black ink or pencil for your final draft; do NOT use colored pencils, markers, or crayons, as they do not reproduce well.

There will be three age categories: grades 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, with a winner in each category. All winners will have their bookmarks reproduced for distribution during National Library Week, Certificates of Achievement and a prize! Bookmarks receiving an Honorable Mention distinction will be on display in the Library's Youth Services Department along with the creator's name and age category.

Entry deadline is March 10, 2012; all entries must be delivered to the Youth Services Department of the Acorn Public Library by 5 p.m. on March 10. Participants may submit up to two entries, but each entry must be on a separate form.
