- Accepted into a college or university for consecutive academic year
- Declare Education as a major
- Complete, sign and include attached application, essays, and teacher recommendation

Only complete applications will be considered

Considered applications will be scored and weighted as follows:

- Essay (50%)
- Academics (15%)
- Activities/Service (15%)
- Teacher Recommendation (10%)
- Personal Accomplishment Statement (10%)

All applications are judged by SD 145 staff chosen by the PTO.

The decisions of the judges are final.
