The applicant with the highest score will be named winner of The Dr. James Upchurch Scholarship and will receive a scholarship valued at \$750.00

Mr. Patrick Ahern

Mr. Ahern devoted 24 years of his career to SD 145, including holding the Principal position at Morton Gingerwood prior to his move into administration as Assistant Superintendent. It is with great pleasure that the second of two general scholarships, valued at \$750.00, is named in his honor and awarded to the applicant with the second highest score.

2. Describe a positive change that could be made in your school's curriculum or building features that would have a major impact in the future quality of education there.
3. What changes can be made in the public education system in the next 10 years in order to improve the quality of education for all students?

- ___ Completed Application and any additional pages
- ___ Official Transcript(s)
- ___ Essay
must be typewritten in a 12 point font, **not to exceed one page**, based on one of the predetermined topic choices listed on application.
- ___ Personal Accomplishment Statement
On a separate sheet, describe for the judges a significant experience in your life that that has made an impact on the person you are today. Must be typewritten in a 12 point font, **not to exceed one page**.
- ___ Completed checklist, including release signature
