



State of Illinois Health Requirements

Students will NOT be able to attend school after **October 15th** until ALL required information is received.

Any student who does not present proof of having had either the required immunizations or physical examination by October 15th of the school term for which such was required or within thirty (30) days of enrollment should enrollment occur after the start of the said school term, may be excluded from school until such time as proof of the required health information is presented.

**Out of state physical forms are only accepted for students transferring into Illinois schools for the first time. The physical must have been completed within one year prior to the date of entry into an Illinois school. The physical form must cover all "required" elements as listed on the Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form.*

Requirements by Grade Level:

Preschool Students:

- Physical Exam (Parents please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date).
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor: (4) DTap, (3) Polio, (4) Hib, (3) Hep B, (1) MMR, (1) Varicella, (4) Pneumococcal.
- Lead Questionnaire or Lead Screening.

Kindergarten Students:

- Physical Exam (Parents please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date).
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor: (5) DTap, (4) Polio, (3) Hep B, (2) MMR, (2) Varicella, (4) Pneumococcal.
- Dental Exam on IL form (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline).
- Eye Exam on Illinois form dated within one year of the first day of school.

2nd Grade Students:

- Dental Exam on IL form (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline).

6th Grade Students:

- Physical Exam (**Sports physical NOT acceptable**, IL Certificate of Child Exam form **required**). Parents, please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date).
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor including **(1) Tdap, (1) Meningitis** – these are 6th grade requirements.
- Dental Exam on IL form (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline).

October 15th is the deadline for all required health information!
