Remote Information

Dear Parents:

Based on your response on the most recent survey, your child will remain on remote status or you have chosen to move your child to remote status. The transition to remote and onsite will take place on Thursday, April 15th. All students will remain remote from April 7th, through April 14th. The daily schedule is attached, and hours will remain 8:30-1:30 on those days. Please note, that if you did not submit a response to the survey, your child will remain on remote status.

Beginning April 15th, students will follow the current schedule as of 3/25/21, that classrooms currently have in place. Remote students will attend Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from 8:55 to 3pm. Wednesdays, are asynchronous days so please make sure to have your child log in, take their attendance, and complete their posted assignments. The schedule for April 15th through May 28th is also attached below.

Please make sure to complete the online attendance form every day. If your child is absent, please call the school and give a reason for the absence. It is important that we know when your child will not be in school and the reason.

Please make sure to log in to your ALMA account and that all phone numbers are current and that voicemail boxes are not full. When phone numbers will not accept incoming calls, mailboxes are full, or numbers are incorrect, we are faced with stressful situations in trying to locate working numbers to communicate important information to you.

We are excited to see the continued growth that our students will be making during this final phase of the school year. We ask that you continue to follow and practice safety measures in your daily lives and remain safe and Covid free.

Again, spring break ends on April 6th. All students will log on virtually on April 7th, an asynchronous day. Live Virtual instruction will begin on April 8th.
