

SOS Full On-Site Direct Instructional Plan:

- **Expectations Enforced for ALL Student/Staff:**
 - **Masks on at all times.**
 - **6ft distancing is maintained between students during instructions and transitions 'as much as possible'***
 - *If 6ft distancing is not available between students, distance will be maintained between pods/classes as much as possible.
- **Student Expectations:**
 - Students will be permitted to carry backpacks to each class throughout the school day.
 - All handbook policies apply, in exception to those specifically described for safety.
- **Instructional/Classroom Expectations:**
 - On-site direct instruction taking place for all classes, with remote learners streaming video meetings while off-site.
 - Students on-site will NOT join online meetings, instead engaging through direct instruction.
 - Class schedules will remain the same.
 - Students must always remain to the right when transitioning through the hallways. The middle lane is reserved for staff.
 - When transitioning between classes students will line up outside classes (distanced) until rooms are clear, then enter.
 - Assigned seats in classes.
 - Students entering each class will be responsible for wiping down their seated area and desk.
 - Specials:
 - Weather permitting PE classes will be held outside. No more than 50 per class, social distanced, and masks worn.
 - On days with inclement weather PE will remain virtual/remote
 - Art, Computers, and Music will always remain virtual/remote.
- **On-Site Student Numbers:**
 - **Dependent upon survey results**
- **Arrival:**
 - Student screening from car-riders/walkers will remain at Door # 3 for temp. check.
 - The gym will serve as private health location for any COVID symptoms or screener failures.
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- **MTSS:**
 - All MTSS classes are held remotely in homeroom class during assigned times.
- **Lunch:**
 - Delivered to classrooms, where students will continue to eat.
 - Students must continue to bring disposable packaging for lunch items.
- **Bell Schedule:**
 - **5-minute passing periods**
- **Dismissal:**
 - Bus riders dismissed first (at 2:30), and with car-riders/walkers dismissed immediately after
 - Bus dismissal procedures will remain the same.
 - Paraprofessionals will continue to supervise hallways/bus area/car-rider areas.
- **Next Steps:**
 - **Remote learning for all will take place from April 7th through April 14th. Wednesdays will remain offsite for staff and asynchronous for students.**
 - **April 14th, staff may enter building in preparation for April 15th arrival for students.**
 - **Thursday, April 15th concurrent instruction begins.**
 - **April 20th will remain as our start date for IAR testing.**
