

## 4 Days On-Site

### MON/TUES AND THUR/FRI


- Two days of direct instruction\*\*\*
  - → Students will physically follow their class schedule.
  - → All classes (including Unified Arts/PE classes) will be held while observing CDC/ IDPH health guidance recommendations.
- ♦ Two days of *in-person* remote learning
  - → Students will remain in supervised groups for on-site remote learning.
  - → All classes (including Unified Arts/PE classes) will continue to be held on the Microsoft Teams.
- Wednesdays are asynchronous (athome, remote) for all learning models.



## 2 Days On-Site

### MON/TUES OR THUR/FRI

- Two days of direct instruction\*\*\*
  - → Students will physically follow their class schedule.
  - → All classes (including Unified Arts/PE classes) will be held while observing CDC/ IDPH health guidance recommendations.
- ◆ Two days *at-home* remote learning.
  - → Students will attend their classes virtually while at home.
  - → All classes (including Unified Arts/PE classes) will continue to be held on the Microsoft Teams.
- Wednesdays are asynchronous (athome, remote) for all learning models.



<u>Full Remote</u>

- Wednesdays are asynchronous (at-home, remote) for all learning models.
